

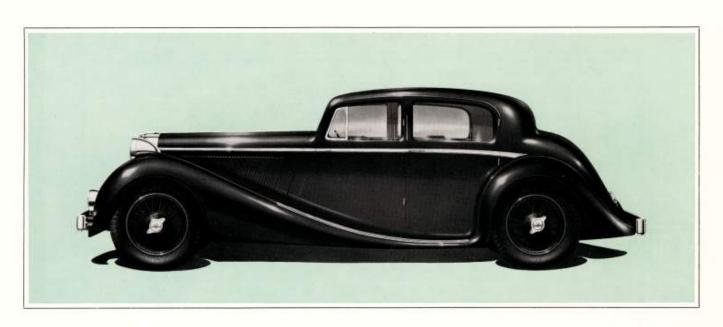

Introduction

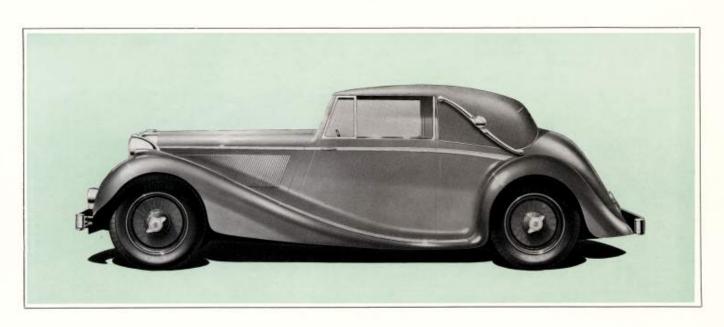
The high reputation for so long enjoyed by the Jaguar car has been built up on its outstanding road performance, fine quality coachwork and the high degree of comfort afforded by its furnishings and appointments. For 1940, these qualities are enhanced by numerous improvements which, in their total, provide even greater luxury and refinement. A special air-conditioning system, incorporating a defroster and demister, is built in as standard equipment on all $3\frac{1}{2}$ and $2\frac{1}{2}$ Litre Saloons and Drop-head models and on the new $1\frac{1}{2}$ Litre Special Equipment models. New type front seats, adjustable for height and pitch as well as for reach, afford added comfort and safety, whilst the luggage locker has now increased accommodation. The Jaguar engine is remarkable for its smoothness and silence and, by special arrangement, its manufacture has been entrusted to the Standard Motor Co. Ltd., who have laid down special plant for its production. Prices for 1940 remain unaltered, but one new model is introduced in the form of a specially equipped $1\frac{1}{2}$ Litre Saloon or Coupe, priced at £318 and £338 respectively. 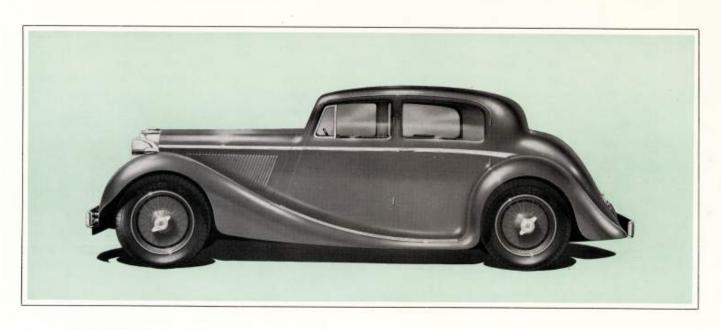
THE 31 LITRE SALOON

UTSTANDING by the sheer merit of its splendid performance, this beautifully proportioned Saloon is firmly established in its leadership of contemporary design. Instantly responsive, either to bursts of vivid acceleration or long-sustained periods at high speeds, this car can be handled with an ease that is as satisfying as it is exhilarating. The comfort afforded to driver and passengers is of the most luxurious order, whilst every detail of appointment is carried out with that high degree of refinement found in all Jaguar models. The price of the 3½ Litre Saloon is £445 and the Drop-head Coupe £465.



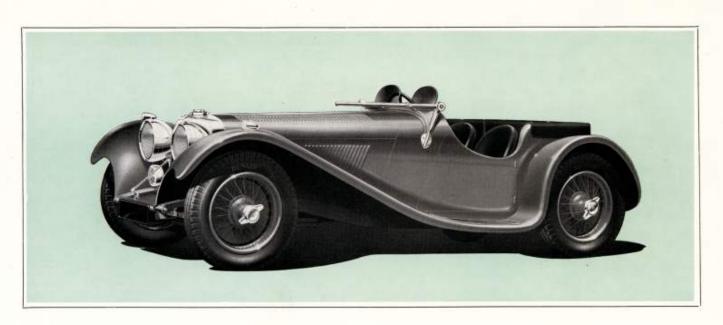
THE DROP-HEAD COUPE

LEGANT, practical, and with the famous Jaguar performance, this Drop-head Coupe combines the advantages of both closed and open cars. The head folds perfectly flush, or the fore part only may be rolled back. Entrance to and exit from the rear compartment is rendered particularly easy by the generous width of the doors. Seating five persons in superlative comfort, the Drop-head Coupe is available on the 3½, 2½ and 1½ Litre chassis. The model illustrated is the 2½ Litre. 1½ Litre model, £318; 2½ Litre model, £415; 3½ Litre model, £465; 1½ Litre Special Equipment model, £338.



THE 11 LITRE SALOON

ITH full five-seater accommodation the 1½ Litre Jaguar is one of the outstanding achievements of the Jaguar programme. Although of moderate nominal horse power, the new O.H.V. engine develops no less than 65 brake horse power, giving a maximum speed of 75 m.p.h. Characterised by the same dignified lines as the higher powered models, the 1½ Litre Jaguar Saloon affords a degree of comfort and a measure of refined performance unmatched by any other car of its type. The price of the standard model is £298 for the Saloon and £318 for the Drop-head Coupe. The Special Equipment model (see specification) is priced at £318 for the Saloon and £338 for the Coupe.



THE "100" OPEN MODEL

HE Jaguar "100" has for long been one of the fastest unsupercharged cars on the road and, in the hands of private owners, has registered numerous outstanding successes in competition work. Available either in 2½ Litre or 3½ Litre form, it has a performance exceeding 100 m.p.h. in full touring trim. Noteworthy for its road-holding qualities, superb acceleration and ease of control, the Jaguar "100" makes special appeal to the motorist demanding the uttermost in performance. The model illustrated is the 3½ Litre. 2½ Litre model, £395; 3½ Litre model, £445.

In the majority of cases, the extras are proprietary articles, the prices of which are fixed by the manufacturers. Owing to the fluctuating nature of the demand for extras, it is impracticable to establish separate works fastilities for the purpose of fitting them, nor is it possible to apply normal production and assembly routine in this direction. The fitting of extras thus presents difficulties in the form of interrupted routine, for which appropriate charges have to be made—but which are set at the lowest possible figure.
