




XJ 12









Impressively neat in its beautifully engineered compartment, the 6.0 litre overhead-camshaft V12 engine has been developed from the famous 5.3 litre unit, variants of which have achieved hundreds of motor racing victories, notably in 6.9 litre form against the world's finest sports cars in the 1988 Le Mans 24-hour race.

With new flat-top pistons and revised combustion chambers, and with the stroke increased from 70 to 78.5 mm, raising the capacity from 5345 to 5994 cc, the power is now

318 BHP (234 kW) at 5400 rev/min. The maximum torque, responsible for the engine's remarkable flexibility, low-down punch and pulling power, is a massive 342 lb-ft (463 Nm) at only 3750 rev/min.



Smoothness and refinement are even more remarkable than before, through improved crankshaft balancing and a modified camshaft profile.

Thanks in part to a revised Lucas Marelli electronic engine management system and a new low-loss catalyst exhaust system, fuel consumption remains surprisingly low: at a steady 56 mph, 26.6 mpg (10.6 l/100 km) at 90 km/h is achieved, and even 21.7 mpg at 75 mph (13.0 l/100 km at 120 km/h).


And, like every other Jaguar engine, each power unit is individually tested both on the bench and in the completed car, first on a rolling road and then on the actual road by an experienced tester.




THAT INCOMPARABLE POWER UNIT


UNMISTAKABLY SPORTING

The XJ12 looks very much a Jaguar, smooth and elegant, but it has a definite sporting air that sets it apart. The purposeful black grille,

with its distinctive gold Jaguar head badge, is flanked by four headlamps, which have power-wash jets. At the side, the aggressive character is confirmed by the gold-badged alloy lattice wheels and the twin sports coachline.

A sporting character from every angle!






UNRIVALLED SPECIFICATION AND VALUE

Understandably, emphasis has been placed upon the outstanding sporting appeal of the XJ12. However, equally important are the typical Jaguar appointments and benefits, of which some are:

- The air conditioning system, a standard fitment, which now has a CFC-free refrigerant.
- The superior audio system, with 8 speakers and RDS (Radio Data System). A 6-disc CD autochanger mounted in the boot (which has a carefully planned layout maximising its



- Electrically heated exterior mirrors which can automatically dip when reverse is selected, and an optional heated front screen.

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
Acceleration from 0-60 mph in 6.8 secs (0 to 100 km/h in 7.2 secs) and a maximum speed (where conditions and legislation permit) of

155 mph (250 km/h): these would be sparkling figures for an out-and-out sports car.

For a large saloon, they are quite remarkable, and give a good idea of the character of the new Jaguar XJ12.

They are even more remarkable when one realises that this sparkling performance is not achieved at the expense of the luxury, comfort, safety and, above all, refinement for which Jaguars are famous. XJ12 passengers can relax and enjoy being conducted as much as the keen driver will revel in controlling this outstandingly sporting machine - a machine, moreover, which is backed by a new 3-year 60,000 mile (100,000 km) warranty, with 6 years' cover against corrosion, and 3 years' against paintwork and surface corrosion, plus full RAC Incident Management.



Despite today's crowded roads and restrictions, there are some rare cars that still provide the sheer driving pleasure which can be enjoyed

for its own sake. Effortless power must be there, of course, together with responsive handling, roadholding, ride and - if possible! - refinement. As you would expect, the new Jaguar XJ12 presents an unrivalled combination of these virtues.

To complement the XJ12's performance is precise rack-and-pinion power steering and an all-independent sports suspension system with uprated front springs, dampers and anti-roll bar. A limited slip differential is also a standard feature.

The anti-lock power braking system has two-piston front disc calipers to match exactly the car's weight distribution. This is just one of the XJ12's safety features, which include energy-absorbing front and rear structural members, anti-intrusion door beams, a steel bulkhead isolating the fuel tank, and a sophisticated inertia switch which shuts off the ignition and unlocks the doors in the event of a collision.

Externally, a hint of the XJ12's character is given by the 8" x 16" forged alloy wheels shod with low profile 225/55 tyres - and a proud Jaguar XJ12 silver badge on the boot.









COMFORTABLY IN COMMAND

Luxurious hand-crafted leather and hand-cut polished veneers play their traditional Jaguar role even in the sporting environment of the XJ12's driver's compartment, but the V12 badge on the walnut finished glovebox reminds one that this is no ordinary luxury saloon.

Providing the shoulder and upper back support required in a sporting car (and with electric adjustment for the lumbar region), the driver's leather trimmed seat (with optionally extra electric heating) is electrically adjustable for height, tilt and reach. The driver's seat also has two-position memory which includes head restraint and exterior mirror settings. (Electric heating and memory are optionally extra on the passenger's seat).

The 5-position tilt-adjust steering wheel has an integral Supplementary Restraint System in the form of an airbag on the driver's side. There are clear analogue instruments with a walnut finish surround, 18 'secret until lit' warning lights, and an LCD diagnostic message centre which doubles as a trip computer.

The new GM4L80E 4-speed automatic transmission, with 'Sport' and 'Normal' modes, has a revised and improved '1-gate' selector. This gives the driver the degree of control essential in a car as sporting in character as the Jaguar XJ12.
